Welcome

Mennabroom is a small farmstead, dating from the 13th century, nestled on the southern slopes of Bodmin Moor in South East Cornwall.

It is set in a beautiful wooded valley and only 30 minutes from both north and south coasts, and situated close to both A38 and A30.

We offer luxury bed and breakfast accommodation in the farmhouse, and self-catering accommodation in our three dog-friendly holiday cottages, which have been converted from a range of traditional 17th Century stone barns.

Visitors are free to walk and explore the 15 acres of fields and deciduous woodland which is intersected by the River Dewey. This whole area attracts a wide variety of wildlife and provides beautiful peaceful walks.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to Mennabroom Farm B&B - The Dewey room by train.
- The nearest train station is Bodmin Parkway. The train station is 7.6 miles / 12.2 km from Mennabroom Farm B&B - The Dewey room.
- Bodmin Parkway is 7.6 miles away and 18 minutes by car. Newquay airport is 28 miles away and 35 minutes by car.

Therefore we recommend that a car is required to complete the journey to us and fully enjoy the many attractions available in Cornwall.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point does not have a dropped kerb.
- From the parking to the main entrance, there is 1 step. There is no ramp and no lift.

Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is 1 step. There is no ramp and no lift.

Main entrance

- The door is 840mm wide.
- The main entrance has 1 steps.

Getting around inside

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have bedside lamps, desk or table lamps and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- No bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- We can move the bedroom furniture, to improve accessibility.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 15 steps.
- All bedrooms are ensuite.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.

Place to eat and drink

Breakfast room

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there are 4 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- To get to a table, there are no steps.
- The menu is offered in large print.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music sometimes.

- We cater for vegetarian, gluten free (celiacs), lactose free (dairy free), nut free and vegan specific diets.

Communal lounge

- From the main entrance to this area, there is 1 step. There is no lift and no ramp.

Getting around outside

Patio

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 840mm wide, or more. The entrance is 840mm wide.

Customer care support

Accessibility equipment

- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
- We can charge wheelchairs and scooters in our garage

- We have information in large print.
- Staff are available 24 hours a day.
- We live on site so are around for much of the day and overnight but cannot guarantee 24 hour cover.
