Welcome

Mennabroom is a small farmstead, dating from the 13th century, nestled on the southern slopes of Bodmin Moor in South East Cornwall.

It is set in a beautiful wooded valley and only 30 minutes from both north and south coasts, and situated close to both A38 and A30.

We offer luxury bed and breakfast accommodation in the farmhouse, and self-catering accommodation in our three dog-friendly holiday cottages, which have been converted from a range of traditional 17th Century stone barns.

Visitors are free to walk and explore the 15 acres of fields and deciduous woodland which is intersected by the River Dewey. This whole area attracts a wide variety of wildlife and provides beautiful peaceful walks.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to Mennabroom Farm Cottages The Shippon by train.
- The nearest train station is Bodmin Parkway. The train station is 7.6 miles / 12.2 km from Mennabroom Farm Cottages - The Shippon.
- Bodmin Parkway is 7.6 miles away and 18 minutes by car. Newquay airport is 28 miles away and 35 minutes by car.
 - Therefore we recommend that a car is required to complete the journey to us and fully enjoy the many attractions available in Cornwall.

If arriving by plane or train, Enterprise cars of Bodmin will happily meet you with a hire car.

Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with Parnells by calling 01208 75000. The taxi company has a
 wheelchair accessible vehicle.
- You can get a taxi with Paul's taxi by calling 07886 188245.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.
- From the parking to the main entrance, there are 6 steps. There is no ramp and no lift.

Arrival

Path to main entrance

• From the street to the main entrance, there are 6 steps. There is no ramp and no lift.

Main entrance

- The door is 810mm wide.
- The main entrance has 1 steps.
- This entrance has a handrail.
- When you arrive, we can help carry your luggage.
- The outside lights work on a movement sensor. There is an inside light just inside the door.

Getting around inside

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, wall lights, bedside lamps and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. Some lights can be controlled independently.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 1 steps.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.
- Some showers have a handrail.
- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the left and right.

Self catering kitchen

Kitchen

- We have a separate kitchen and dining room. From the main entrance to the kitchen, there is 1 step. There is no lift and no ramp.
- The work surface is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.
- The hob is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.
- The sink is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.
- The oven is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.

- From the main entrance to the dining room, there are 2 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- There is a step from the kitchen and bedrooms side of the cottage, down to the dining/living room

Lounge

Liviving/dining room

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there are 2 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- There is a step from the kitchen and bedrooms side of the cottage, down to the dining/living room

Getting around outside

Communal garden and grounds

- From the main entrance to the gardens, there are 6 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- The route is sloped.

Sitting out area

• From the main entrance to the area, there is 1 step.

Customer care support

Accessibility equipment

- The nearest toilet area for assistance dogs is located within the front garden, 6 metres from the main entrance.
- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
- We can charge wheelchairs and scooters in our garage

- We have information in large print.
- We live on site so are around for much of the day and overnight but cannot guarantee 24 hour cover.
